



H-CUBE RECOMMENDATIONS

H-CUBE partners collected and analysed information and data regarding good practices of: **targeted services and actions to raise awareness of HBV, HCV and HIV and their prevention among young people** aiming to help Public Administrations and NGOs in the participating countries to address in the best way the organisation of future prevention campaigns.

In order to transfer the good practices identified in the non-participating countries and to organize the best H-CUBE European Prevention Campaign in the participating ones, the project partners have set the “H-CUBE RECOMMENDATIONS”, 10 points useful for PAs or NGOs dealing with STIs issues (especially HBV, HCV and HIV) and involved in the organization and implementation of prevention activities addressing young people aged 15-24.

The following recommendations have been identified according to the mapping of experiences and the selection of the most effective best practices on the base of predetermined criteria identified by the project consortium and validated by 3 external independent experts in the field. These recommendations should be taken into consideration as suggestions or starting points to be adapted to the local situation in the maximum respect of the social, cultural, religious values and educational system and in cooperation with local partners with solid experience in STIs prevention.
